INTENT

Music is an integral part of the curriculum at Backworth Park Primary School, and above all, it is our intent that we make music an enjoyable learning experience in both our curriculum and our extra-curricular activities. We encourage all our children to participate in a variety of musical experiences through which we aim to build up their musical appreciation and exposure to the wonderful world of music.

We recognise that singing is a great starting point for musical learning and the development of many skills, while being a hugely enjoyable activity for our pupils and teachers. We intend to create a strong and positive bond within our school and join the community together-marking significant moments by singing and playing together, and listening to music during assemblies, performances, musical visits and special events in the calendar.

Our teaching will develop the children's ability to sing in tune and with each other, and through singing they will also learn about the structure and organisation of music. As we teach them to listen and to appreciate the many different forms of music, they will learn the musical language necessary to express how music represents feelings and emotions.

IMPLEMENTATION

Music is carefully planned for progression and continuity. We use Charanga and Sing up, to complement the curriculum and scaffold the learning opportunities throughout the key stages. Units of work plan for all areas of the curriculum, which are returned to and developed in a spiral pattern of learning. It provides many examples of music styles and genres from different times and an exciting array of cultures. We plan for cross curricular learning opportunities where possible.

All children are actively encouraged and given the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument, from tuned and un-tuned classroom instruments, to whole class instrumental tuition and individual instrumental lessons with visiting peripatetic staff. All children will experience being part of an ensemble; working, composing and performing together. The use of technology and the understanding of appropriate notation will be an integral part of this learning.

At Backworth Park Primary School, we strive to develop community links by providing our children with the opportunity to perform and work with music specialists.

Our commitment to ensure all of our children reach their potential in music is supported through enhancement activities such as trips, extra-curricular clubs and working with agencies such as Rocksteady and Little Beethoven's Music School.
