The Service Pupil Premium



The Service Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011 in recognition of specific challenges faced by children whose parents are in service and as part of a commitment to the armed forces covenant.

It is designed to assist the school in providing the additional support that these children may need and is currently worth £310 per service child who meets the eligibility.

Eligibility Criteria:

- One of their parents serving in the regular armed forces
- They have been registered as a 'service child' in the school census
- One of their parents died whilst serving in the armed forces and the pupil receives a pension under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme
- Pupils with a parent who is on full commitment as part of the full-time reserve service

Eligible schools receive the SPP so that they can offer mainly pastoral support to children during challenging times and to help mitigate the negative impact on service children of family mobility or parental deployment.

Schools have flexibility over how they use the SPP as they are best placed to understand and respond to the specific needs of those pupils.
