There are 41 children on the SEN register at present, which is 12% of the children on whole school roll including Nursery.

We have 4 children with EHCP's (10%).

37 children require SEN support.

EYFS

In the EYFS, within the Reception cohort, there were 5 SEN children. 0% achieved GLD. Performance of SEN pupils in the school is in-line with the performance of SEN pupils nationally.

Phonics

In phonics, 57% of SEN children passed the Year 1 Phonic Check. This is higher than Local Authority data and National data.
