Teach your family how to sing "1, 2, 3, 4, 5, once I caught a fish alive!" Remember to show them the actions too	There are many fish under the sea. Can you think of 3 other words that contain the 'sh' sound?	Design an outfit you could wear at the beach. Get your adult to draw an outline of clothing and design what you would like on it.	Some animals that live under the sea have fins to help them move around. Other animals have legs to move around with. Can you think of some sea creatures that have fins and some that have legs? Draw a picture of them.
Can you make your own lighthouse using recycled materials.	Can you help Miss Sharp count her shells? She had 5 shells, but the sea washed 2 of them away. How many shells did she have left? You could use objects to help you work out the answer.	Find out 3 facts about a creature that lives under the sea to share with the rest of the class.	Draw your favourite sea creature. You could use pens, pencils or paint to colour it in. Add your name to your picture too.
Imagine you have found a magic shell. You can have one wish. Draw a picture to show us what your wish would be!	Can you visit a local beach?	Have a look around your home and find 2 things that you think will float and 2 things that you think will sink. Ask a grown-up to help you test if you are right.	Can you make a model of a sea creature? You could use playdough, a paper plate or bowl, cardboard boxes and tubes. Maybe you could make a fish, an octopus or a jellyfish with lots of tentacles!
