Write a list of objects you have used and place a tick or cross to let us know if that material is waterproof or not.

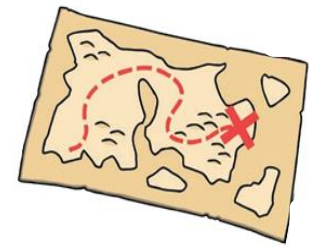


Personal, social and emotional development
